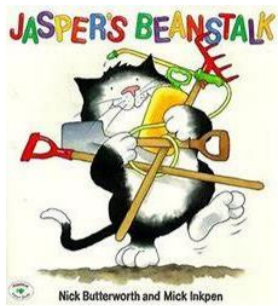


Toddler & Pre-Schooler Room

This term, we had a blast learning about growing plants and reading "Jasper's Beanstalk." The children loved the story and sharing their thoughts during our discussions. Some shared why the bean took so long to grow and what would happen if they climbed the beanstalk. "I think a giant will be there," said Noor, while others imagined themselves climbing the beanstalk.



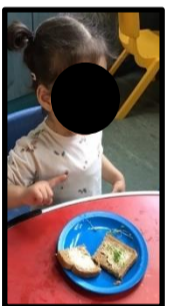
Children created and decorated their own magic beans with playdough, each one unique and special. We explored fruits and veggies to find seeds, examining them closely and discovering seeds of all shapes and sizes.



As part of our learning journey, we conducted a cress seed germination experiment. We planted cress seeds using two different methods: some in soil and others on moist paper towels.



The children followed simple instructions carefully, making sure to plant their seeds just right. They took turns watering the plants every few days. After just one week, many of our seeds had sprouted, making the children super happy. Some were worried if their seeds didn't grow, but we reminded them that it takes time, just like in the story.

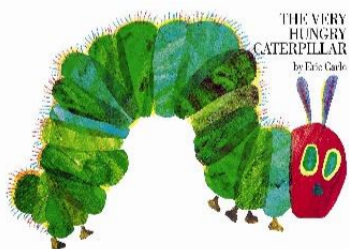

Names on Clothes



To prevent items from going missing, we kindly ask that all children's clothes and jackets are labelled with their names.

Nappies and wipes

If your child is wearing a nappy, please ensure they have at least three nappies and a packet of wipes packed for their time at nursery.



Buggy Area

Due to limited space, we ask that children who can walk to nursery do so, especially as the weather is getting warmer. Walking is a good form of exercise. We do not have space for bikes and scooters. Our buggy area is mainly for parents with children under 2 in pushchairs or for children between 2-3 who need strollers. Please take bikes and scooters home after dropping off your child.
