This term, we focused on the theme of 'Transports and Journeys.' We read two books, 'The Train Ride' and 'Maisy Goes on Holiday.' In the initial weeks, our focus was on different modes of transport including land, water, and air. The children thoroughly enjoyed learning about these and had the opportunity to explore sensory tuff trays, experiment with sinking and floating, engage in arts and crafts, and participate in role-playing activities.



We role-played packing our bags and discussed suitable outfits based on weather conditions, then set off on a journey to the train station in our pretend train station that we created. During circle times, children shared their holiday stories; one child talked about her trip to Morocco through a show-and-tell with pictures from her holiday. Others also shared their plans for upcoming summer holidays.

This term, the babies focused on the book 'Where's Spot?' and learned different positional language such as 'in', 'open', and 'under'. They engaged in a variety of activities, including filling cups with oats, opening lids, hiding soft toys under blankets,

Government-funded Childcare

If your child is turning 9 months before the 31st of August, starting September 2024, the government is providing 15 hours of free childcare. This also includes 2 years old. Please check your eligibility and apply before the deadline, then provide us with the confirmation code to access the 15 hours.



This also applies to working parents with children over 3 years old, who can apply for 30 hours of free childcare for September. Check your eligibility and give us your code once you receive it.

If you do not apply before the deadline, you will miss the term and will need to wait until the next term to access these free hours.
